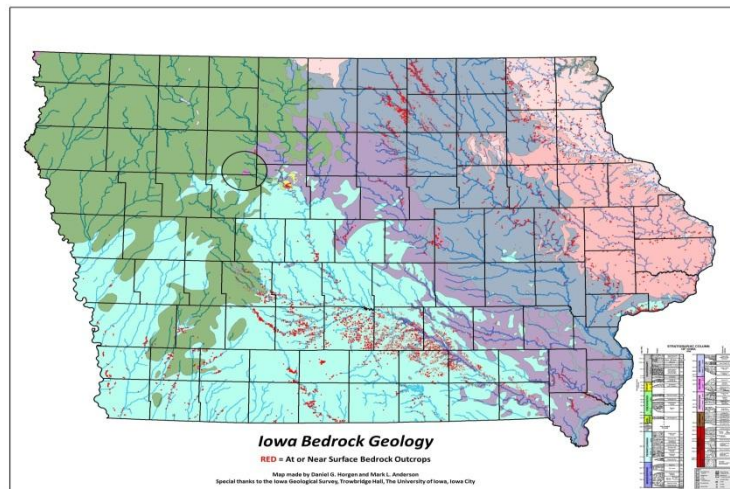
Friday 24 February and Saturday 25 February, 2012
